I'm proud to announce that after an unprecedented and HIGHLY SUCCESSFUL Sail Around, your Sailors and USS COOPERSTOWN have safely arrived at Naval Station Mayport!



You should be EXTREMELY proud of your Sailors for what they just accomplished. This crew just successfully completed a 3,500 nautical mile Sail Around with over 730 miles and 85 hours of restricted waters transits. There is NO HARDER navigational voyage on earth than the one this crew just completed. There are over 330 million people in the United States and less than 700 have executed this voyage through the Great Lakes, The Welland Canal, the St. Lawrence River, out to the Northern Atlantic Ocean and down to Mayport. This was a true, all-hands team effort – well done, HEAVY HITTERS!


